- Be 6 to 16 years of age
- Have their parent (or legal guardian) provide written, informed approval to participate
- Children with a clinical diagnosis of *cerebral palsy*
- Children must use English as their primary language
- Have no medical, psychiatric, or acquire brain injury
- Stable medication with no changes over the past 3 months
- Able to make a clear Yes/No response
- Able to see a 1"x1" picture on a computer screen

Participants can expect to spend approximately two hours in the study, and will be paid a \$50.00 honorarium for their time and effort.
