High Incidence AT (HIAT)

Here's another acronym for you! HIAT refers to High Incidence AT. High Incidence Disabilities are those involving the largest numbers of students and include more than 10% of students in an average classroom. Students with high incidence disabilities can benefit from strategies that help many students.
